The WI will be running a Dog Show again at this year's Summer Fayre. Entries can be taken on the day and it's £1 per dog per category.

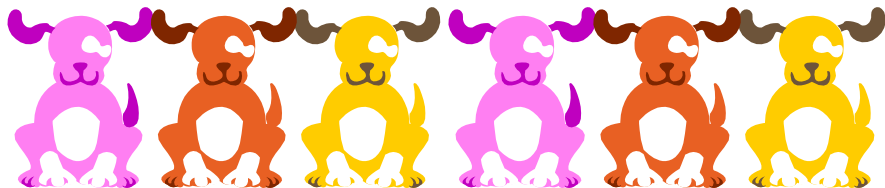

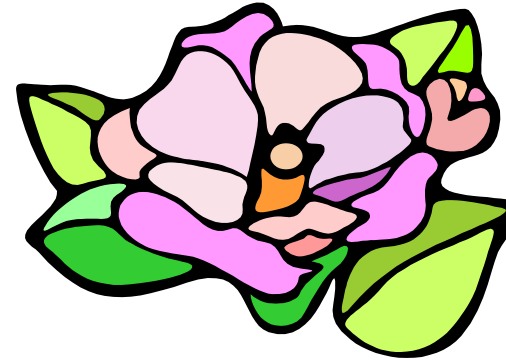
